

## Contest Rules & Guidelines

1. Blocks are constructed by individual students, small groups or an entire class. Students are encouraged to work together.
2. All work should be completed by the student(s) themselves.
3. Students must be affiliated with a school or organization (i.e. church or scout group).
4. Blocks can be original designs or traditional patterns.
5. Blocks must measure 16" x 16" square. Blocks varying more than 1" larger or smaller will be disqualified from the judging. The orientation of the block must be designated on the back.
6. Be creative in using the three Moda Fabrics. A recognizable piece of each of the three fabrics must be included in the block. Additional trims, fabrics, notions, etc. may be added as desired. However, please do not use any loose glitter.
7. Blocks must include some hand or machine stitching, but should not be quilted.
8. Blocks must be presented in a neat, clean condition for exhibition. Please do not mount the blocks in a frame or on a backing board.
9. Please do not staple entry materials to the quilt block.
10. Students should complete the entry form neatly, assisted by their teachers, and attach the form to the back of the block with a paperclip.
11. A student may only submit and be represented in one entry block.
12. All entries must include: a completed entry form (neatly printed or typed) and statement about the block. We encourage you to at least one photo of student working on the block.
13. All completed entries must be submitted (post marked or hand delivered) to the Museum by 5 PM Friday, December 4, 2009.
14. Blocks will be judged and winners will be awarded based on craftsmanship, originality, and creative use of the Moda Fabrics. Award winners will be notified by mail.
